Passenger Terminal Extension

Anticipating air traffic growth



Project description

The first phase of the passenger terminal extension project entails reconfiguring the terminal infrastructure at Blaise Diagne International Airport in Diass, to improve customer experience and support the expected growth in air traffic (post-Covid-19). Ultimately, the aim is to increase passenger capacity to cope with steady growth in traffic at the airport.

Project objectives

Through this project, AIBD SA aims to improve passenger transit conditions by increasing the capacity of Blaise Diagne International Airport in Diass to accommodate 10 millions passengers by 2035, 30% of whom will be connecting passengers. The increase in capacity allows for the handling of freight connections and transits, in line with Diass airport's ambition to become a reference air hub.
